O4-028 The Board received, for information only, a report titled "The Municipal Low Salt Diet" for presentation by the RiverSides Stewardship Alliance.

Mr. Kevin Mercer, Executive Director, and Ms. Jennifer Hounsell of the RiverSides Stewardship Alliance were in attendance. The Board thanked Mr. Mercer and Ms. Hounsell for the information provided and advised that TPA staff have been actively participating in meetings with the City of Toronto looking at appropriate practices for storage, application and disposal of road salts. Following a discussion of the report and a presentation, the Board passed a motion that staff, upon release of Environment Canada's "Best Practices Guidance Document" for the use of road salts on parking lots and private properties, look at the best practices suitable for the Toronto Parking Authority and report back to the Board with a recommended approach. It is expected that Environment Canada will be issuing the guidance documentation in Spring 2004.

- O4-029 At the invitation of the TPA, Mr. David Brady of Hicks Morley Hamilton Stewart Storie, verbally updated the Board regarding the status of upcoming Union negotiations. **Details were discussed in-camera**.
