1.0 FINANCE & ADMINISTRATION

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2.0 DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION

- 2.1 Staff memorandum dated May 24, 2007 recommending that the construction contract for the 2007 Repair Program to Carpark Nos. 34, 36 and 42 be awarded to Trezzi Construction Limited o/a Across Canada Construction for the sum total amount of \$637,300.00 plus GST. For the year 2007, the contract amount will be the sum total amount of \$521,300.00 plus GST.
- 2.2 Staff memorandum dated May 25, 2007 recommending that the construction contract for Parking Garages 11 and 125 2007 Painting Program be awarded to Duron Ontario Ltd. for the sum total amount of \$265,000.00 plus GST.

3.0 PARKING OPERATIONS

Off-Street
