DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION

Board Chair Soulis moved that staff provide an update at the Board's July 24th meeting regarding the TPA's request to the City of Toronto's Facilities & Real Estate Division to address the leakage problems on the Square above the TPA's municipal Carpark 36 garage. Motion was carried.
