1.0 FINANCE & ADMINISTRATION

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3.0 PARKING OPERATIONS

Off-Street

 - 1) \$1.00 per half hour;
 - 2) \$7.00 day maximum (7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.);
 - 3) \$5.00 night maximum (6:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.); and,
 - 4) \$90.00 monthly permit (7-Day Saturday to Sunday) (Quota 20 Permits).
