3.0 PARKING OPERATIONS

- 3.1 Staff memorandum dated October 8, 2009 recommending that:
 - 1) the Board authorizes staff to enter into a contract agreement with Precise Parklink Inc. to facilitate the communications platform upgrade/migration from the Roger's Mobitex Wireless Network to the Roger's GSM/GPRS Wireless network for each of the 2,833 Parkeon pay and display machines currently in use in the Toronto Parking Authority's on-street and unattended off-street parking programs at a unit cost of \$2,696 (PST included) per unit to be indexed annually at a fixed rate of 2.5% effective year two of the 10-year payment plan proposed herein and subject to the Board's approval of Recommendations 2) and 3);
 - 2) the Board authorizes the amendment to the current Extended Warranty – Asset Protection and Renewal Plan agreement with Precise Parklink Inc. that provides a ten (10)-year repayment plan (2009-2019) for the project costs as set out herein;
 - 3) the Board authorizes the extension of the current Extended Warranty – Asset Protection and Renewal Plan agreement with Precise Parklink Inc. for an additional eight (8) years from the current termination date of 2016 to the year 2024; and,
 - 4) the Board approves the expenditure of \$54 per unit to facilitate minor repairs to and the repainting of a pay and display machine as required/determined by Authority staff.
