3.0 PARKING OPERATIONS

Off-Street

- 3.1 Staff memorandum dated July 17, 2008 recommending approval of rate changes identified in Schedule "AU" Unattended Facilities and Schedule "AA" Attended Facilities of staff's report for implementation on September 2, 2008. Changes to monthly rate to be effective October 2008. The rates were reviewed with the Rate Review Committee of the Board at its meeting on Monday, July 14, 2008.
