15-125 The Board confirmed the minutes of the July 30, 2015 meeting.

FINANCE & ADMINISTRATION

PARKING OPERATIONS

The Board approved a staff memorandum dated August 24, 2015 recommending that the contract for the provision of Winter Maintenance Services (snow plowing, salting and removal) for the Toronto Parking Authority off-street parking facilities for the five (5) year term commencing November 1, 2015 and ending April 30, 2020 be awarded to Across Canada Construction Limited for the total contract price of \$4,748,375.00 (annual indexed price changes and HST non-included).

The Board approved a staff memorandum dated September 2, 2015 recommending the expenditure of \$65.00 per pay and display machine for a turnkey transport and installation solution, inclusive of all costs (vehicle, fuel, equipment, insurance, labour, materials and supplies), excluding applicable taxes, for the pick-up, removal, transport and redeployment of the machines from/to their in-service location under the P&D Machine Refurbishment Program, payable to Precise Parklink Inc (the estimated total value is in the order of \$201,500.00, based on an inventory of 3,100 machines, and may vary up or down depending on the actual number of machines picked-up/installed under the project).
