For the amount of \$17,500.00 plus \$2,500.00 contingency allowance being the sum total amount of \$20,000.00 plus HST.

- 2.3 Staff memorandum dated November 11, 2016 recommending that the contract for retaining a prime retail consultant for Municipal Carpark 1 (Charles/Hayden Garage) be awarded to G Architects for \$30,000.00 plus a 15.0% contingency allowance, or \$4,500.00, being the sum total amount of \$34,500.00 plus HST.
